Notice is hereby given that pursuant to the provisions of Section 110 and all other applicable provisions, if any, of Companies Act, 2013 (**the “Act”**), read together with Rules 20 and 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (including any statutory modification(s) or re-enactment(s) thereof, for the time being in force) (**“Rules”**), Regulation 44 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (the **“SEBI Listing Regulations”**), General Circular Nos. 14/2020 dated 8th April, 2020, 17/2020 dated 13th April, 2020, 20/2020 dated 5th May, 2020, 22/2020 dated 15th June, 2020, 33/2020 dated 28th September, 2020, 39/2020 dated 31st December, 2020, 10/2021 dated 23rd June, 2021, 20/2021 dated 8th December, 2021, 3/2022 dated 5th May, 2022, 11/2022 dated 28th December, 2022, 9/2023 dated 25th September, 2023 and 09/2024 dated 19th September, 2024 issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Government of India (**“MCA Circulars”**), Secretarial Standard on General Meetings (**“SS-2”**) (as amended) issued by the Institute of Company Secretaries of India and any other applicable law, rules and regulations (including any statutory modification(s) or re-enactment(s) thereof, for the time being in force), the resolution set out below is proposed to be passed by the Members of **Sanghi Industries Limited (the “Company”)** by means of Postal Ballot, only by way of remote e-voting (**“e-voting”**) process.

The proposed resolution and the Explanatory Statement pursuant to Section 102, 110 of the Act and any other applicable provisions of the Act, read with Rules framed thereunder, setting out the material facts and reasons thereof concerning the resolution mentioned in this Postal Ballot Notice ("**Notice**"), are annexed hereto.

In compliance with Regulation 44 of the SEBI Listing Regulations and pursuant to the provisions of Sections 108 and 110 of the Act read with the Rules framed thereunder and the MCA Circulars, the manner of voting on the proposed resolution is restricted only to e-voting i.e. by casting votes electronically instead of submitting postal ballot forms. The instructions for e-voting are appended to this Notice.

Pursuant to Rule 22(5) of the Rules, the Board of Directors of the Company has appointed Mr. Chirag Shah, Practicing Company Secretary (Membership Number FCS: 5545 COP: 3498) as the Scrutinizer for conducting the postal ballot (e-voting process) in a fair and transparent manner.

Members are requested to carefully read the instructions mentioned under the head 'General information and instructions relating to e-voting' in this Notice and record their assent ("**FOR**") or dissent ("**AGAINST**") on the proposed resolution through the e-voting process only not later than 5:00 p.m. (IST) on Friday, 25th October, 2024 failing which it will be considered that no reply has been received from the Member.

The Company has engaged the services of Central Depository Services (India) Limited (hereinafter referred to as "**CDSL**" or "**Service Provider**") for facilitating e-voting to enable the Members to cast their votes electronically instead of dispatching postal ballot forms. In accordance with the MCA Circulars, the Company has made necessary arrangements with Link Intime India Private Limited, Registrar and Share Transfer Agent ("**RTA**") to enable the Members to register their e-mail address. Those Members who have not yet registered their email address are requested to register the same by following the procedure set out in this Notice. The postal ballot results will be submitted within 2 (Two) working days from conclusion of the e-voting period to the stock exchanges in accordance with the SEBI Listing Regulations.

The Scrutinizer will submit the results of the e-voting to the Chairman of the Company or any other authorized officer(s) of the Company after completion of the scrutiny of the e-voting. The results of the Postal Ballot along with the Scrutinizer's Report will also be displayed on the website of the Company at <https://www.sanghiment.com/> on the website of CDSL at www.evotingindia.com and shall also be displayed at the Registered Office of the Company while simultaneously being communicated to the National Stock Exchange of India Limited and BSE Limited where the equity shares of the Company are listed.

The proposed resolution, if approved, by the requisite majority of Members by means of Postal Ballot will be taken as having duly passed on the last date specified for e-voting i.e. Friday 25th October, 2024.

3. In accordance with the MCA Circulars, the Notice is being sent in electronic form only. The hard copy of the Notice along with the Postal Ballot forms and pre-paid business envelope will not be sent to the Members for the Postal Ballot. Accordingly, the communication of the assent or dissent of the Members would take place through the e-voting system only.
4. In compliance with the provisions of Section 108 and 110 of the Act read with Rules 20 and 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, as amended from time to time, Regulation 44 of the SEBI Listing Regulations and SS -2 issued by the Institute of Company Secretaries of India on General Meeting, the Company is offering e-voting facility to enable the Members to cast their votes electronically. The instructions for e-voting are provided as part of this Notice.

5. 6. It is clarified that for permanent registration of e-mail address, the members are however requested to register their e-mail address, in respect of electronic holdings with the Depository through the concerned Depository Participants and in respect of physical holdings with the Company's RTA to enable servicing of notices, etc. electronically to their e-mail address.
7. The e-voting rights of the Shareholders / beneficiary owners shall be reckoned on the shares held by them as on Friday, 20th September, 2024 being the Cut-Off date for the purpose. The shareholders of the Company holding shares either in dematerialised or in physical form, as on the Cut-Off date, can cast their vote electronically.
8. The voting rights for the equity shares of the Company are one vote per equity share, registered in the name of the member. The voting rights of the members shall be in proportion to the percentage of paid-up share capital of the Company held by them. In case of joint holders, only such joint holder who is higher in the order of names will be entitled to vote.
9. A member cannot exercise his / her vote through proxy on postal ballot. However, corporate and institutional members shall be entitled to vote through their authorised representatives. Corporate and institutional members (are required to send scanned certified true copy (PDF Format) of the board resolution / authority letter, power of attorney together with attested specimen signature(s) of the duly

10. Once the vote is cast, whether partially or otherwise, the member shall not be allowed to change it subsequently or cast the vote again.
11. Postal Ballot (e-voting) period commences from Thursday, 26th September, 2024 (9:00 a.m. IST) and ends on Friday 25th October, 2024 (5:00 p.m. IST). At the end of the e-voting period, the facility shall forthwith be blocked and e-voting shall not be allowed beyond the said date and time.
12. The proposed resolution, if approved, by requisite majority, shall be deemed to have been passed on the last date of e-voting, which would be Friday, 25th October, 2024. The resolution passed by the Members through Postal Ballot are deemed to have been passed as if the same has been passed at a general meeting of the Members.
13. General information and instructions relating to e-voting:

- i. The voting period begins on Thursday, 26th September, 2024 (9:00 a.m. IST) and ends on Friday, 25th October, 2024 (5:00 p.m. IST). During this period, the shareholders of the Company, holding shares, as on the cutoff date (record date) viz., Friday, 20th September, 2024 may cast their votes electronically. The e-voting module shall be disabled by CDSL for voting thereafter.

- ii. Pursuant to SEBI Circular No. SEBI/HO/CFD/CMD/CIR/P/2020/242 dated 9th December, 2020 and under Regulation 44 of the SEBI Listing Regulations, listed entities are required to provide remote e-voting facility to its shareholders, in respect of all shareholders' resolution. Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account(s) maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants. Shareholders are advised to update their mobile number and E-mail ID in their demat accounts in order to access e-voting facility.
- iii. Currently, there are multiple e-voting service providers (ESPs) providing e-voting facility to listed entities in India. This necessitates registration on various ESPs and maintenance of multiple user IDs and passwords by the shareholders.

In order to increase the efficiency of the voting process, pursuant to a public consultation, it has been decided to enable e-voting to all the demat account holders, by way of a single login credential, through their demat accounts / websites of Depositories / Depository Participants. - (iv) Shareholders holding shares in physical form will then directly reach the Company selection screen. However, shareholders holding shares in demat form will now reach 'Password Creation' menu wherein they are required to mandatorily enter their login password in the new password field. Kindly note that this password is to be also used by the demat holders for voting for resolution of any other company on which they are eligible to vote, provided that company opts for e-voting through CDSL platform. Mehta & Co., Chartered Accountants, the existing Statutory Auditors have vide their letter dated 16th July, 2024 tendered their resignation to be made effective from the closure of business hours of 29th July, 2024 as the Company is considering to align the process for appointment of Statutory Auditors within the cement vertical of Adani Group wherein Audit of all the Listed Companies within the cement vertical is to be conducted by the Statutory Auditors of the Holding Company i.e. Ambuja Cements Limited.

Due to resignation of M/s. S. K. Mehta & Co., Chartered Accountants, Statutory Auditors and pursuant to the provisions of Section 139 of the Companies Act, 2013 and the rules framed thereunder, the Board of Directors is required to fill the casual vacancy of the Statutory Auditors office within 30 days caused due to resignation of a Statutory Auditors subject to such appointment shall also be approved by the Shareholders of the Company within three months of the recommendation of the Board and the said Statutory Auditors shall hold office till the conclusion of the next annual general meeting.

The Company has received eligibility certificate as required under Section 141 of the Companies Act, 2013 from S R B C & Co. LLP, Chartered Accountants (FRN: 324982E / E300003) and they have conveyed their consent to be appointed as the Statutory

Auditors of the Company along with a confirmation that their appointment if made by the members, would be within the limits prescribed under the Companies Act, 2013.

The Board of Directors of the Company recommends the resolution for the approval of shareholders of the Company as an Ordinary Resolution.

None of the Directors, Key Managerial Personnel of the Company or their respective relatives, are in any way concerned or interested financially or otherwise in the said Resolution except to the extent to their shareholding in the Company, if any.
